 **Copyright:** You retain your copyright. In addition, you choose how your research can be used with a [Creative Common License](#) that suits you. We recommend CC BY-NC-ND but are happy to discuss options.


 **Formats:** Your book will be available as an ebook (Open Access) and in print (for sale). This means you will still earn royalties on any print copies sold through our distribution network.

 **Payment:** Book Processing Charges (BPC) can be paid by research grants, your institution or a collection of libraries. Many grants stipulate an Open Access publication, making you compliant with the requirements. Publicly funded research becomes accessible, meaning taxpayers get more value for money.

 **Discoverability:** We distribute Open Access titles as widely as possible. Partners include the [DOAB](#), library and other ebook platforms, and we make them available on our website.

 **Network:** Pre-publication payment means that any researcher in the world benefits from free access to your work, fostering future collaboration opportunities and strengthening your research networks.

 **Sharing:** You are invited to share your research as widely as possible among your social and professional network. Accelerate knowledge discovery through sharing on your website, social media, Research Gate, mass media, preprints and repositories.

 **Reach:** Without a paywall, your research can be read and cited by a wider range of academics globally, right from publication. This includes countries that might otherwise not be able to afford access to academic content. Your reach is not limited to academics: Practitioners, and even members of the public, are able to access and apply your findings, and your book can influence policy makers globally.
